

# Investing for Success

## Under this agreement for 2017 Mundingburra State School will receive

**\$312,927\***

### This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' or above in English in P-6 from 86.5% (Sem 1 2016) to above 90% (Sem 2 2017)
- Increase the number of students in NAPLAN upper two bands in Year 3 Reading from 47.3% to above 50% and Year 3 Writing from 31% to above 35%
- Increase the percentage of Prep students reaching reading benchmarks from 43% (Sem 1 2016) to above 50% (Sem 1 2017)

### Our initiatives include

- Provide professional learning in 'Teaching with a literacy focus' through co-planning, collaborative inquiry cycles and co-teaching to develop teachers' knowledge and understandings of the Australian Curriculum: English and increasing their competency to identify and implement effective instructional strategies utilising the gradual release model
- Provide time for teachers to analyse learning with knowledgeable others to make decisions about the next instructional strategies required and provide feedback to students against success criteria
- Use OLEY (Oral Language for the Early Years) and a four lesson reading sequence in Prep to guide teachers and teacher aides in implementing high yield strategies for beginning readers and writers

Employ additional Support Teachers Literacy and Numeracy and Speech Language Pathologist to work intensively with teachers and students to improve literacy teaching and learning	175 500
Employ additional teacher aides to implement guided reading, intensive support with speech and other literacy skills	78 800
Provide teachers with quality professional learning within and beyond the school including shared planning, collaborative inquiry cycles and co-teaching opportunities	58 627
